Copyright

Please make sure to transfer the copyright to Plansee Group Service GmbH, otherwise your paper cannot be published in the proceedings. After the 19th Plansee Seminar 2017, you are free to publish your paper in future works, such as press releases, lectures, reviews etc., as long as the following phrase is inserted between title and summary: "Presented at the 19th Plansee Seminar, May/June 2017".

Responsibility

Papers will be reproduced as submitted by the author(s). There will be no refereeing by the Scientific Committee. However, in case of non-compliance of the manuscript in layout, orthography, language etc., the editors reserve the right to implement minor corrections, or return it to the author(s) with the request for corrections.

Deadline for Paper Submission

1 March, 2017

All papers submitted by this date will be distributed on a USB flash drive at the beginning of the seminar. The full conference proceedings will be available electronically after the seminar in September 2017. Please note that only papers presented at the Plansee Seminar will be published in the conference proceedings.

Paper Preparation and Formatting

Minimise your time and effort by using the provided template which will automatically ensure correct formatting and layout of your paper!

The conference language is English. Your paper shall not exceed a total number of 12 pages including figures and references. The typing area (margins 3 cm at the top, 1.5 cm all other sides) as provided by the template should be fully utilized. Please do not add page numbers, headers or footers.

Lettering: Font style throughout the paper is Arial, please refer to table I and the template for further details.

The **Abstract** (length 10–18 lines) shall be placed at the beginning of the paper below the title, authors name(s) and affiliation(s).

Keywords: In order to support automated search routines, please supply between 3 and 7 keywords.

Figures and Tables shall be inserted into the text at the appropriate place. Please do not accumulate figures and tables at the end of the paper. **Numbers** identifying formulae shall be written in parenthesis at the right margin in the same line as the formula.

References shall be numbered consecutively in order of appearance in the text. Please refer to the template for citation rules.

Paper Submission

Please upload your paper in MS Word format at the Seminar website www.plansee-seminar.com until 1 March, 2017. The file name should include the **abstract number** provided in your acceptance e-mail; please make sure the file is **not write-protected**.
